- 1. Must be a graduating high school senior.
- 2. Scholarships are contingent and subject to the recipient graduating from high school and passing any required graduation exam.
- 3. If an applicant's parents live in two different foundation districts, the applicant may apply for a scholarship in only one of them.
- 4. Scholarships will not be awarded based on need.
- 5. Recipients must be considered a full-time student by the institution at a four-year college, junior college, technical or vocational school.
- 6. Recipients must be dependent on a member of a participating Alabama electric cooperative at the time the application is made and through graduation from high school.
- 7. The one-time scholarship will be available for use during the four academic years directly following the student's high school graduation.
- 8. Scholarships will be paid by the Foundation directly to the institution selected on your application unless notification is made of any changes to hdutton@areapower.com prior to July 1, 2026. Any changes made after July 1, 2026, will be subject to delays based on the return of the scholarship to the Foundation.

The Electric Cooperative Foundation, Inc. was created by the electric cooperatives of Alabama in 1997 in an effort to give back to the communities they serve by providing scholarships for post-secondary and vocational education to accredited institutions for qualifying high school seniors. In the spring of 2026, the Foundation will award scholarships to dependents of members of the participating electric cooperatives in each of the 21 districts established by the Foundation's Board of Directors.
